3. Noted that the Defence Forces Week and 42nd Tarehe Sita Celebrations would be held on Monday 6<sup>th</sup> February 2023 in



Mbarara City under the theme *‘Recognizing the Sacrifice of the Founders of the Peoples’ Revolution for Social Economic Transformation’*

6<sup>th</sup> of February (Tarehe Sita in Swahili) was designated as the UPDF (NRA by then) symbolic founding Day and celebrations are held annually in different regions on a rotational basis.

This year’s celebrations are in recognition of the sacrifice by His Excellency General Yoweri Kaguta Museveni, as the leader of the Uganda Revolution together with his comrades whose vision and values become the bedrock of National peace, stability and prosperity over the last 42 years.

The choice for Mbarara sub region as the main focus of the 42<sup>nd</sup> Tarehe Sita celebrations is particularly informed by the need to trace and link the current peace, security, stability and development, to the earlier efforts in the struggle, particularly, the anti-Amin Front for National Salvation (**FRONASA**), and to document their contributions in the struggle to liberate this country.

4. Approved the Nomination of the Minister of State for Environment to serve as a member of the Global Leaders Group on Antimicrobial Resistance that is intended to:
  - i. Maintain urgency, public support, political momentum and visibility of antimicrobial resistance challenge on the global agenda;
  - ii. Monitor and report on progress, gaps and accountability in the global response to antimicrobial resistance;
  - iii. Provide advice and guidance on reports of the Independent Panel on Evidence for Action against Antimicrobial Resistance;






- iv. Monitor and advocate for the inclusion of antimicrobial resistance and a One Health “Lens” in investment and programs of major financing instruments for agriculture, health, development, food and feed production and other relevant areas.

Representation on the Global Leaders Group on AMR is a strategic position that among other things:

- Increases Uganda’s visibility as a leader on the Global stage. It is an opportunity to Globally project, present and spearhead the environmental issues that Uganda cares about and wishes to offer Global leadership on.
- Enhance Uganda’s leadership and networks with partners and donors to enable her attract possible multilateral and bilateral funding for Environmental protection and climate change management.
