3. Approved the Principles for the Technical, Vocational Education and Training (TVET) Bill, 2022 with the following Objectives;

- (i) Establishing an institutional Framework for the; promotion coordination, regulation and delivery of TVET;
- (ii) Providing for implementation of Policies, decisions and directives issued by the Minister;
- (iii) Streamlining the development and management of TVET trainers and managers;
- (iv) Providing registration and management of Crafts persons, Technicians and Technologists;
- (v) To provide, expand and manage TVET Qualifications Framework;
- (vi) To define the scope of TVET courses and programmes and the role of the different stakeholders in the Provision of the training among others;

4. Approved the Implementation FATF Recommendation 24: Amendment of the Insolvency Act, 2011 and the Companies Act, 2012;

- (i) To comply with the World Bank Ease of Doing Business Index that provides an objective basis for understanding and improving the regulatory environment for doing business around the World;
- (ii) To have in place measures aimed at preventing misuse of legal persons for money laundering and terrorism financing;
- (iii) To implement the requirements on beneficial ownership disclosures aimed at increasing transparency and accountability in the oil, Gas and Mining sector.
