
**BRIEFING TO THE MEDIA ON CABINET DECISIONS TAKEN DURING
THE CABINET MEETING HELD ON MONDAY 27TH JANUARY 2020 AT
STATE HOUSE ENTEBBE**

Cabinet sat on Monday January 27th, 2020 at State House - Entebbe, and;

1. Noted that Uganda will be hosting the 46th Session of the African Regional Labour Administration Centre Governing Council Meeting (ARLAC-GCM) in Kampala from 10th to 14th February 2020. Benefits of hosting the ARLAC Conference include:
 - (i) The choice of hosting the meeting is a vote of confidence in the leadership of the Country and its achievements locally and internationally;
 - (ii) Hosting the event provides a convenient forum for promoting African Unity and discussion;
 - (iii) Uganda stands to benefit from ARLAC Labour Administration Training, Development and Research Programmes through improved Skills and Competencies of the Labour Administration Institutions and Structures in the Country.

2. Approved the Periodic Report of Government of Uganda on the implementation of the United Nations Convention on the Elimination of all forms of Discrimination Against Women. The objective of the Report is to

give an account of the Government's efforts to eliminate all forms of discrimination against Women and Girls and respond to the concluding observations and recommendations of the UN Committee on the Elimination of Discrimination against women.
