TALKING POINTS FOR THE MINISTER OF STATE FOR RELIEF, DISASTER PREPAREDNESS AND REFUGEES

I welcome you all to this function when we as the Ministry for Relief, Disaster Preparedness and Refugees are flagging off relief food meant for people who were severely affected by hunger in Karamoja Sub region. This is food that was procured from the 20BN that Office of the Prime Minister received this quarter out of the 135BN that was approved by Cabinet.

The dry season in Karamoja Sub region started to unfold in December, 2021but it however, worsened in February, 2022. As Office of the Prime Minister, we immediately commenced relief food distribution following early warning alerts from UNIEWS at the beginning of this year.

According to the Integrated Phase Classification (IPC) report of April, 2022, 41% of the population were food insecure. Between March to July 2022, we have been able to dispatch 51,240 bags of maize flour -50 kgs each and 25,620 bags of beans- 50 kgs each to Karamoja Sub region. This is approximately 2,562 MT of maize flour and 1,281 MT of beans.

From the 135 BN that was earmarked to address the problem of hunger in Karamoja Sub region, 20 BN was released by Ministry of Finance Planning and Economic Development to OPM this quarter. As such, the procurement process for relief food immediately started and food has now been procured.
